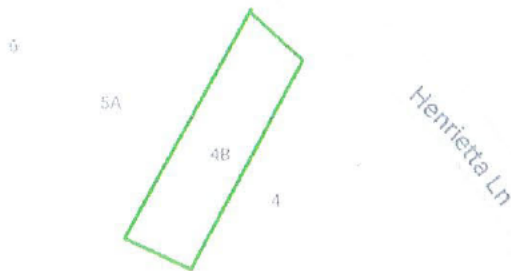

Re: Proposed Addition to the RPS Ref. 8850

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN,

I am writing to object to the proposed addition of two walls and a vaulted area at 4b Henrietta Lane to the Record of Protected Structures.

One of these walls is on to Henrietta Lane and it is clearly not an 18th century structure, as claimed here. This wall is a poorly constructed 20th century addition made from random rubble. This can clearly be seen in the patch of wall that has been exposed by render falling off due to water damage.

The boundary wall with 5 Henrietta Lane is also of no architectural significance and should not be included on the RPS.

The vaulted area to the rear of [REDACTED] property is on the ground floor and is under the raised garden of 4 Henrietta Street, already on the RPS. This is therefore a needless, superfluous addition to the RPS.
