All submissions and observations will be published online within 10 working days of receipt in accordance with the requirements of the Planning and Development Act, 2000 (as amended). Your address will not be published. You are responsible for ensuring that no vexatious, libellous or confidential information, including confidential information in relation to a third party (in respect of which the third party has not, expressly, or impliedly in the circumstances, consented to its disclosure) is included in your submission or observation. The Planning Authority reserves the right to redact any submission/observation or part thereof that does not comply with this requirement.

The final date and time for receipt of submissions or observations is 4.30pm on Monday 14th February 2022. Please note late submissions/observations will not be considered.
